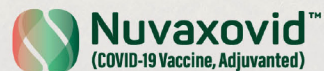

WITH NUVAXOVID™
(COVID-19 VACCINE, ADJUVANTED)



INDICATION

NUVAXOVID is a vaccine to protect against COVID-19 for people who are:

- 65 years of age and older, or
- 12 years through 64 years of age at high risk for severe COVID-19

Vaccination with NUVAXOVID may not protect all people who receive the vaccine.

NUVAXOVID does not contain SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes COVID-19.

NUVAXOVID cannot give you or your child COVID-19.

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IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

You or your child should not get NUVAXOVID if you had a severe allergic reaction to a previous dose of NUVAXOVID or to any of its ingredients.

There is a remote chance that the vaccine could cause a severe allergic reaction, which would usually occur within a few minutes to one hour after getting a dose. For this reason, the vaccination provider may ask you or your child to stay at the place where you or your child received the vaccine for monitoring after vaccination. Signs of a severe allergic reaction can include: difficulty breathing, swelling of the face and throat, a fast heartbeat, a bad rash all over the body and/or dizziness and weakness.

Myocarditis (inflammation of the heart muscle) and pericarditis (inflammation of the lining outside the heart) have occurred in some people who have received NUVAXOVID. The chance of having this occur is very low. You should seek medical attention right away if you or your child have any of the following symptoms after receiving the vaccine: chest pain; shortness of breath; feelings of having a fast-beating, fluttering, or pounding heart.

Other side effects reported in clinical trials and/or post-approval use of NUVAXOVID include: Injection site reactions (pain/tenderness, swelling, redness and itching), fatigue or generally feeling unwell, muscle pain, headache, joint pain, nausea, vomiting, fever, chills, allergic reactions such as hives and swelling of the face, swollen lymph nodes, paresthesia (unusual feeling in the skin such as tingling or a crawling feeling), and hypoesthesia (decreased feeling or sensitivity, especially in the skin).

WHO IS NUVAXOVID FOR?

- ✓ Adults aged 65+
- ✓ Individuals aged 12-64 with at least one condition that puts them at high risk for severe outcomes from COVID-19

You can get NUVAXOVID regardless of which COVID-19 vaccine you've had previously. It can also be given at the same time as your flu shot.

COVID-19: STILL HERE. STILL A THREAT



COVID-19 still presents a serious health risk, especially if you are **older or have certain underlying conditions**



COVID-19 leads to **increased risk of major cardiac events**, such as stroke and heart attack



The hospitalization rate for COVID-19 was **~2x higher than flu** in adults 18+

CONDITIONS THAT CAN INCREASE RISK

If you are over 65 years of age and/or have an underlying condition, you are at elevated risk of severe COVID-19.

Around 75% of American adults are at high risk due to underlying conditions, such as:

- Cancer
- Cerebrovascular disease, including stroke
- Chronic lung, kidney, and liver diseases
- Diabetes (type 1 or type 2)
- Heart failure and heart conditions
- Mental health conditions, including depression
- Physical inactivity, overweight/obesity
- Weakened immune system

WHAT IS NUVAXOVID?

PROTEIN-BASED TECHNOLOGY



NUVAXOVID is a protein-based, non-mRNA vaccine built for routine, seasonal COVID-19 vaccination



It's made with technology already used for certain modern flu vaccines



It's the only recombinant protein-based, non-mRNA COVID-19 vaccine available

POWERFUL PROTECTION

In a 2022 clinical study evaluating efficacy and safety in 25,510 adults aged 18 and older,

~90% effective in protecting against illness from COVID-19
100% protection against moderate-to-severe disease

FAQs

Can I get NUVAXOVID if I previously had an mRNA vaccine for COVID-19?

Regardless of which COVID-19 vaccine you've had in the past, you can ask for the protection of NUVAXOVID.

Is it possible to get NUVAXOVID at the same time as a flu shot?

Getting your flu shot and COVID-19 shot at the same appointment is supported by numerous medical authorities. NUVAXOVID is a protein-based, COVID-19 vaccine made with technology already used for certain modern flu vaccines.

How much will NUVAXOVID cost?

NUVAXOVID is available at no cost for most eligible patients. It's \$0 for Medicare Part B and for most people with Medicare Advantage or private insurance plans.

Is NUVAXOVID the same as NOVAVAX?

NUVAXOVID is the same vaccine that was previously manufactured by NOVAVAX. It's now manufactured by Sanofi and updated to match this season's COVID-19 strain.
